ACCREDITATIONS AND CERTIFICATIONS



Varna Free University has institutional accreditation from the National Evaluation and Accreditation Agency at the Council of Ministers of the Republic of Bulgaria – 9.01 on a scale of 10.



On February 18, 2025, the University was recertified for the eight time in a row by the international certification organisation BUREAU VERITAS Certification for compliance with the international standard ISO 9001:2015. No other institution of higher education in Bulgaria has a 24-year unbroken certification cycle for quality management.



In 2023, VFU "Chernorizets Hrabar" became the first Bulgarian university certified according to ISO 14001:2015 for environmental management. The University changes both the environment and the quality of instruction, meeting the highest sustainability standards based on educational, economic, environmental and social criteria. The topics related to the implementation of the ESG standards are integrated in the University's Bachelor's, Master's, and Doctoral programmes.



DEPARTMENT OF FOREIGN LANGUAGE TEACHING AND POST-GRADUATE QUALIFICATION

The Department of Foreign Language Education and Postgraduate Qualification delivers instruction in foreign languages (English and Russian) in accordance with the Common European Language Framework. The Departments organises Bulgarian language courses for international students and provides additional courses of Japanese, Chinese and Portuguese language and culture.

The Department offers specialized language courses for professional fields: law, business, architecture, civil engineering, computer science, tourism, diplomacy and diplomatic correspondence, business correspondence, advanced literacy, academic communication.

The Department provides the opportunity to acquire a university certificate for the level of knowledge of foreign languages. The foreign language courses included in the curricula guarantee excellent preparation for the exam for its acquisition. Students can certify their knowledge and skills in a foreign language at the beginning of their studies at the University, which gives a number of advantages:

- The certificate attests the language proficiency that is a condition for applying for mobility under the Erasmus+ programme or other international student exchange programmes or internships abroad.
- The certificate offers proof to every employer in Bulgaria and abroad for the holder's knowledge and skills in a foreign language.

The Department hosts a Language Centre with a rich library collection of over 1000 titles. The resources are accessible through the University Library's electronic catalogue. The centre offers excellent conditions for holding scientific-practical conferences, methodological seminars, discussions, educational lectures and courses.


CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE SECRETARY

CLASS SCHEDULE AND EXAM DATES

EUROPEAN CREDIT TRANSFER AND ACCUMULATION SYSTEM (ECTS)

Students' instruction is carried out in accordance with the European Credit Accumulation and Transfer System (ECTS). It ensures the mutual recognition of certain study periods in European universities and supports mobility of students and faculty.

The credits are a numerical expression of the class hours (lectures and seminars) and extracurricular workload (individual projects, exams and other forms of assessment, internships, trainings, etc.) that students take for the course of their studies. Students are awarded credits upon successful completion of all components of the respective class or module after passing an exam or other form of assessment.

The system provides for the accumulation of a minimum of 60 credits in one academic year or a minimum of 30 credits per semester. They are distributed by courses and modules, according to the curriculum of the specialty and educational degree. The Bachelor's degree requires a minimum of 240 credits and the Master's degree after secondary education – minimum 300 credits.

CURRICULUM

The curriculum of each specialty contains compulsory, elective and optional subjects.

The curricula for the academic programmes are published on the University's website: https://ects.vfu.bg/

The forms of assessment of the knowledge and skills acquired by the students are: exams, ongoing assessments, defense of course projects and other forms of assessment. Grading is based on a six-point system (with words and integers), along with letter designations according to the European system for the accumulation and transfer of credits, as follows: Excellent (6) - A; Very good (5) - B; Good (4) - C; Average (3) - D, E; Poor (2) - F, FX (no credits awarded).



EXAMINATION PROCEDURES

Exam sessions are: regular, remedial and liquidation.

Students who have not paid their semester fees by the due date will not be admitted to the examination session. Students who have not sat the regular or the remedial exam session, or received grade Poor – F/FX, have to attend the liquidation session with an individual exam protocol, which is issued after paying an administrative fee and filling out an electronic form no later than seven days before the exam date.

Students who, after a liquidation session, have three failed exams, may enroll in an upper academic year conditionally by passing the exams by the end of the winter semester of the respective academic year. The conditional enrollment is granted by the dean of the faculty upon his/ her discretion. Conditional postponement of failed exams in the last year of study is not allowed.

ACADEMIC ADVISORS

The personal attitude towards the students is of primary importance at Varna Free University.

The academic advisor is an instructor who is responsible for the group of students in the respective year of their studies. His or her task is to maintains an effective and personal relationship with each of the students in the class for the successful progress of their studies.

APPLICATIONS AND REQUESTS

Applications and requests are submitted to Students Services or electronically through the student's electronic file in the Student status module on the website of VFU "Chernorizets Hrabar". Students can apply for/request:

INDIVIDUAL EXAMINATION PROTOCOLS • Transfer to another higher education institution

- Deferred payment
- Semester fee reduction
- Interruption of studies
- Re-enrollment
- Transfer from one form of learning (regular/correspondent) to another or from one specialty to another

- Permanent session or for postponement of examination/examination session for valid reasons
- Issuance of an academic transcript
- Other applications/requests

These are issued for a liquidation session, equivalency exams or for other reasons, according to the Ordinance on Educational Activity of VFU "Chernorizets Hrabar", upon payment of an administrative fee and filling in an electronic form no later than seven days before the exam date.

INTERRUPTION

Student leave for a period of one academic year is permitted by the dean of the faculty:

- at the student's request based on an application submitted to the Front office or electronically before the start of the academic year and upon payment of an administrative fee.
 - administrative suspension of studies in case of not passing more than three exams after a liquidation session or unpaid semester fee.

During the suspension period, students may sit the missed exams only with an individual protocol issued after paying an administrative fee and completing an electronic form no later than seven days before the exam date.

RE-ENROLLMENT

After the expiration of the suspension period, the student submits an application for restoration of his rights and enrolls in the next semester, provided he has passed all failed exams. The student can to restore his student rights up to three months after expiration of the suspension period. After this period, the student is considered to have quit his/ her studies and the restoration of student rights requires re-application and adjustment to the relevant curriculum of the new graduating class. Applications for restoration of student rights are submitted to the Front office or electronically before the start of the respective semester.

The permanent session enables the student to sit for examinations on dates other than those scheduled his/her academic year and form of education with free individual exam protocols until the end of the school year. Permanent session is allowed to students with severe illnesses, people with disabilities, mothers with children up to 6 years old and for other valid reasons.

The student submits an application in the Front office or electronically, accompanied by documents justifying the need for permanent session. A permanent session is permitted provided that the semester fee for the current semester has been paid.

FAST-TRACKED EDUCATION

Students can shorten the duration of their studies by one year, provided they have successfully completed their first year with a grade point average no lower than Very good (5). Students taking up fast-tracked study pay semester fees for the full course of studies.

TRANSFER

The transfer of students from one specialty to another, from one form of study to another or to another higher education institution is allowed after successful completion of the first year and the payment of the required administrative fee or penalty. Applications are submitted to the Front office or electronically until the beginning of the school year. In case of transfer to another higher education institution, a penalty amount is paid at 100% of the semester fee.

GRADUATION

Training in each specialty to obtain the relevant educational qualification degree ends with a state exam or a thesis defense according to the current legislation and approved curricula for the specialty. Students are admitted to the state exam or thesis defense provided that they have successfully passed all semester exams and completed the other requirement of the academic programme.

HEALTH INSURANCE

Students in the regular form of education who are under the age of 26 and are not subject to health insurance on different legal grounds according to the Health Insurance Act, fill out a health insurance declaration with the enrollment documents.

If the declared circumstances change, students are required to fill out a new declaration, which they submit to office # 111 – Finance and Accounting Department.

SEMESTER FEES

The payment of the semester fees is made before the start of classes. In case of non-observance of the specified period, the student owes compensation for delay in the amount of the legal interest for each day overdue. A student who has not paid the semester fee is not admitted to the exam session and is subject to administrative suspension. If the fee for a distance learning programme is not paid within the specified deadline, the student's access to the distance learning platform is interrupted.

DEFERRED PAYMENT

NATIONAL ELECTRONIC STUDENT CARD (NESC)



https://nesc.nacid.bg

The National Electronic Student Card (NESC, Bulgarian: HECK) verifies the enrolment status of students or doctoral candidates and entitles their holders to discounts and services at higher education institutions, student canteens, museums, theatres, public transport, and other venues.

The card is issued automatically based on information provided by the higher education institution or research organisation. Access is obtained by activating a profile in the National Electronic Student Card portal, for which NACID (National Center for Information and Documentation) sends an email. If the automatic message is not received, a new email can be requested through the portal.

Issuance and use are free of charge. The card is valid for the entire period of study and is reissued only in case of a change in personal data. It can be used as a paper document or directly via a mobile device. Individuals without "Active" status do not have access to the NESC.

Uniform Academic Number (UAN)

The Uniform Academic Number (UAN, Bulgarian: EAH) is the personal identification number of the student or doctoral candidate in the national register. It is used to verify the validity of the card and the current enrolment status: Active, Interrupted, Inactive, In the process of graduation, or Graduated. The data in the portal depend on the timely submission of information by the respective higher education institution or research organisation.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT IDENTITY CARD (ISIC) AND EUROPEAN YOUTH CARD (EYC)

The International Student Identity Card (ISIC) and the European Youth Card (EYC) are document certifying the status of a student. These provide discounts for full-time students in Bulgaria and all over the world – transport, museums, entertainment, shopping, restaurants, travel, and accommodation.

- ISIC for full-time students
- EYC for correspondent students up to 30 years of age.

Both cards serve as campus access passes. They are valid for four years for university access and for one year for discounts, after which they must be renewed. The cards are personal and non-transferable. In case of loss or misuse, security must be notified and an application for a new card submitted.

Master's programmes

After completing higher education in the chosen specialty, any student with a higher diploma education with grade point average no lower than Good (4), can continue and upgrade his studies in the Master's programmes of Varna Free University. VFU "Chernorizets Hrabar" offers over 40 Master's programmes in seven professional fields. The programmes are available in regular, correspondent and distance learning modes.



Postgraduate qualification

The University offers courses for acquiring additional professional qualification "Teacher of ...": informatics and information technologies; economics; fine arts; vocational training. The certificate for additional professional qualification "Teacher of ..." applies to persons with higher education diploma according to the Ordinance on the State Requirements for Acquiring Teacher's Professional Qualification.



The programmes in the professional areas of Administration and management, Economics, Informatics, Computer science and Psychology allow students to choose between broad-ranging training with the acquisition of a second specialty or the concentration on specialized training, without an increase in the programme duration and tuition fees.

Doctoral programmes

The Doctoral programmes of the Varna Free University are a tool for realising one of the main strategic priorities of the academic leadership. The acquisition of skills for using modern methods and techniques of scientific research is among the advantages of studying in a doctoral programme.

The Centre for Doctoral Training at VFU "Chernorizets Hrabar" can boast of dozens of young researchers from Israel, Poland, Kazakhstan, Lebanon, Ukraine, Turkey, the Russian Federation studying in over 20 doctoral programmes.
