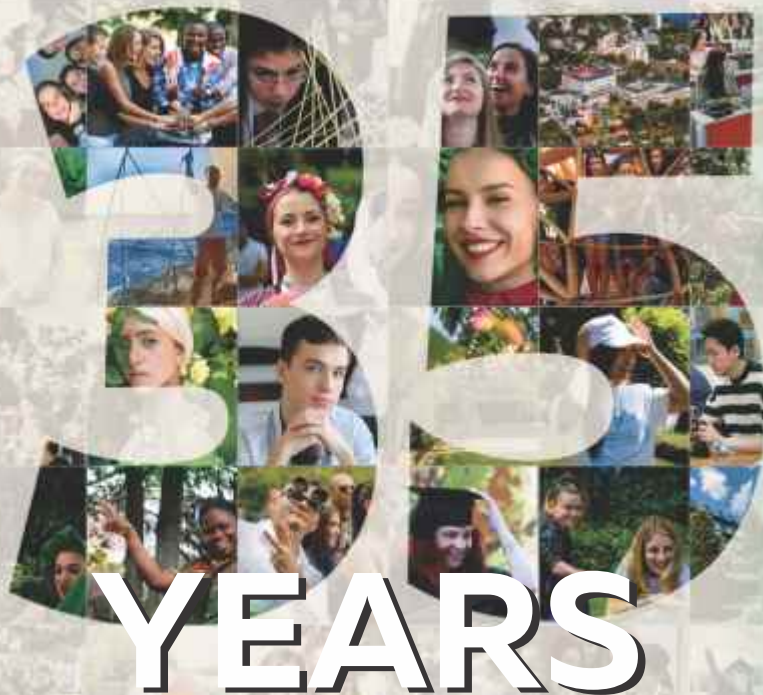

Varna Free University "Chernorizets Hrabar" was established on March 27, 1991. On July 27, 1995, it received the status of an institution for higher education by decision of the 37th National Assembly (published in the State Gazette, issue 68 of August 1, 1995).

Varna Free University "Chernorizets Hrabar" has one of the most modern campuses in Bulgaria.



About VFU “Chernorizets Hrabar”

The campus covers an area of over 20,000 square metres. It is located right next to the resort complex Golden Sands and the natural park of the same name. In addition to the educational and the administrative building, the campus comprises specialised and training centres – University Library, Centre for Digital Technologies, modern Educational and Sports Complex, Career Centre, Educational Media Centre, Centre for Vocational Training, Language Centre, Educational Courtroom "Prof. Tamara Hinova", Forensics and Forensic Expertise Lab, Investigation Tactics and Methodology Lab, Medico-Psychological Complex, dormitory, canteen, cafeteria, parking facilities, parks, and wonderful recreation areas.

The picturesque sea panorama forms a natural backdrop to the park of Varna Free University “Chernorizets Hrabar.” It was created in 2012 as a project by students of the Architecture programme.

Varna Free University also has a branch in Smolyan, which provides access to quality European education for young people from the Rhodope region. The academic complex enables students to study close to home and develop their professional potential in a modern university environment. The branch connects education with the needs and development of the region.



ACCREDITATIONS AND CERTIFICATIONS



Varna Free University has institutional accreditation from the National Evaluation and Accreditation Agency at the Council of Ministers of the Republic of Bulgaria for the maximum accreditation period, with a score of 9.01 on a scale of 10.



On February 18, 2025, the University was recertified for the eighth time in a row by the international certification organisation BUREAU VERITAS Certification for compliance with the international standard ISO 9001:2015. No other institution of higher education in Bulgaria has a 24-year unbroken certification cycle for quality management.



In 2023, VFU "Chernorizets Hrabar" became the first Bulgarian university certified according to ISO 14001:2015 for environmental management. The University changes both the environment and the quality of instruction, meeting the highest sustainability standards based on educational, economic, environmental and social criteria. The topics related to the implementation of the ESG standards are integrated in the University's Bachelor's, Master's, and Doctoral programmes.

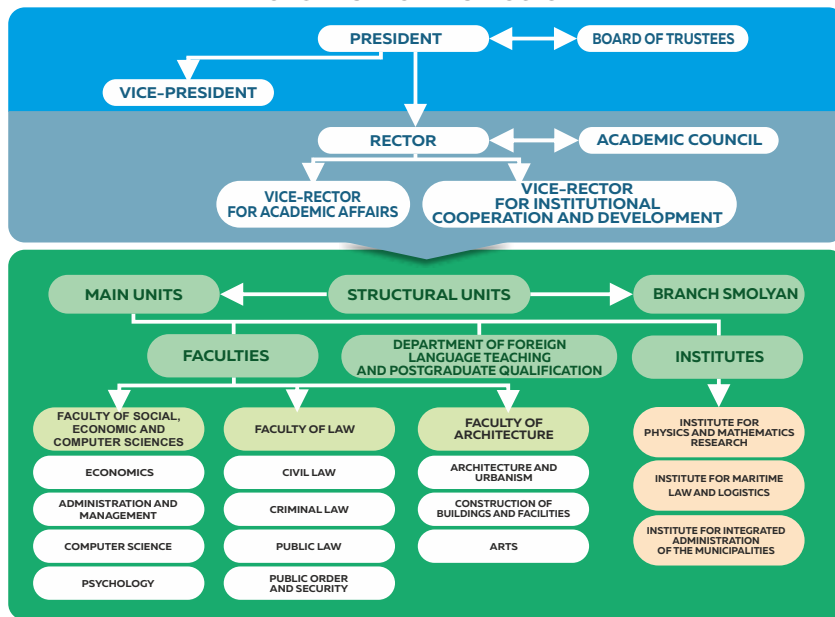

DEPARTMENT OF FOREIGN LANGUAGE TEACHING AND POSTGRADUATE QUALIFICATION

The Department of Foreign Language Teaching and Postgraduate Qualification delivers instruction in foreign languages in accordance with the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages. The Department organises Bulgarian language courses for international students and provides additional courses of Japanese, Chinese and Portuguese language and culture.

The Department offers specialised language courses for professional fields: law, business, architecture, civil engineering, computer science, tourism, business correspondence, advanced literacy, academic communication.

The Department provides the opportunity to acquire a university certificate for the level of knowledge of foreign languages. The foreign language courses included in the curricula guarantee excellent preparation for the exam for its acquisition. Students can certify their knowledge and skills in a foreign language at the beginning of their studies at the University, which gives a number of advantages:

- The certificate offers advantages when applying for Erasmus+ mobility, participating in international student exchange programmes and undertaking internships abroad.
- The certificate enhances the holder's competitiveness in the labour market by providing employers in Bulgaria and abroad with evidence of the holder's foreign-language proficiency.

The Department hosts a Language Centre with a rich library collection of over 1000 titles. The resources are accessible through the University Library's electronic catalogue. The centre offers excellent conditions for holding scientific-practical conferences, methodological seminars, discussions, educational lectures and courses.

CENTRE FOR DISTANCE STUDIES

Varna Free University has more than 15 years of experience and tradition in distance studies. Students use high quality educational resources that are accessible from anywhere in the world at any time. A programme for individual consultations with the instructors has been created. An individual approach to students is of paramount importance in distance studies.

Students can choose from five Bachelor's degree programmes offered through distance studies. These are Informatics and Computer Science, Business Administration and Management, Public Administration and Management, International Economic Relations, and Finance and Accounting.

Five Master's programmes are available through distance studies to applicants who already hold a higher education qualification. In the field of computer science, these are Digital Marketing and Web Design and Software Engineering and Management (in Bulgarian). Other sought-after Master's programmes include Management and International Marketing, Administrative Infrastructure, and International Finance.

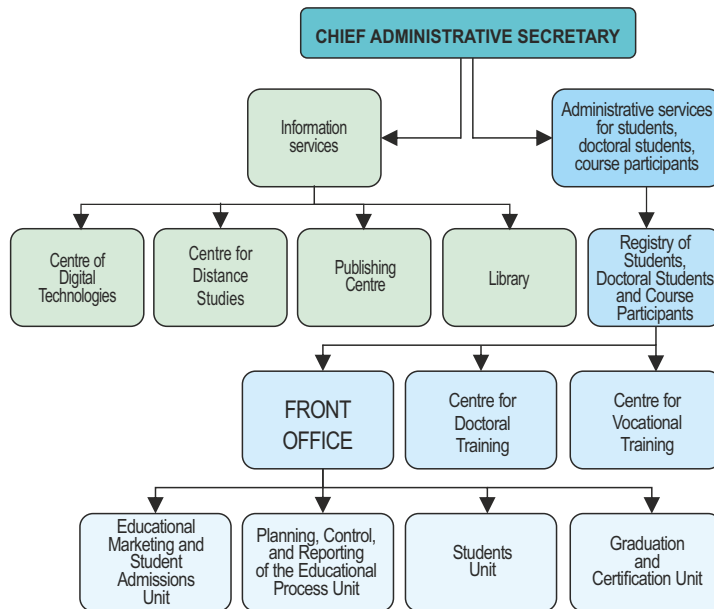
CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE SECRETARY

EUROPEAN CREDIT TRANSFER AND ACCUMULATION SYSTEM (ECTS)

Students' instruction is carried out in accordance with the European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System (ECTS). It ensures the mutual recognition of certain study periods in European universities and supports mobility of students and faculty.

The credits are a numerical expression of the class hours (lectures and seminars) and extracurricular workload (individual projects, exams and other forms of assessment, internships, trainings, etc.) that students take for the course of their studies. Students are awarded credits upon successful completion of all components of the respective class or module after passing an exam or other form of assessment.

The system provides for the accumulation of a minimum of 60 credits in one academic year or a minimum of 30 credits per semester. They are distributed by courses and modules, according to the curriculum of the speciality and educational degree. The Bachelor's degree requires a minimum of 240 credits and the Master's degree after secondary education – minimum 300

CURRICULUM

The curriculum of each speciality contains compulsory, elective and optional subjects.

The curriculum and the syllabuses for individual courses are published on the University's website:

The forms of assessment of the knowledge and skills acquired by the students are: exams, ongoing assessments, defence of course projects and other forms of assessment. Grading is based on a six-point system (with words and integers), along with letter designations according to the European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System (ECTS), as follows: Excellent (6) – A; Very good (5) - B; Good (4) – C; Average (3) – D, E; Poor (2) – F, FX (no credits awarded).



ACADEMIC ADVISERS

An individual approach to students is of primary importance at Varna Free University.

The academic adviser is an instructor who is responsible for the group of students in the respective year of their studies. His or her task is to maintain an effective and personal relationship with each of the students in the class for the successful progress of their studies.



STUDENT STATUS AND ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES

Information on issues related to student status and students' rights and obligations can be found in **Ordinance No. 1 on Academic Activities at VFU “Chernorizets Hrabar”**.



EXAMINATION PROCEDURES

Examination sessions are regular, remedial and final resit sessions.

Students who have not paid their semester fees by the due date will not be admitted to the examination session. Students who have not sat the regular or the remedial exam session, or received grade Poor – F/ FX, have to attend the final resit examination session with an individual examination form (protocol), which is issued after paying an administrative fee and filling out an electronic form no later than seven days before the exam date.

A student may sit an examination to improve a grade on the basis of an application submitted within seven days of the announcement of the examination results. After receiving approval, the student pays an examination fee and submits an application for an individual examination form.

Students who, after a final resit examination session, have three outstanding exams may enrol conditionally in the next academic year, provided they pass the exams by the end of the winter semester of the respective academic year. The Dean of the Faculty or the Director of the Branch may permit conditional enrolment in the next academic year with more than three outstanding exams once during the course of study. If permission is refused, or if more than three exams remain outstanding after the final resit examination session of the following academic year, the student may repeat the academic year. Conditional progression into the final year of study with more than three outstanding exams is not permitted.

ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES

INDIVIDUAL EXAMINATION FORMS (PROTOCOLS)

These are issued for a final resit examination session, equivalency exams or for other reasons, according to the Ordinance No. 1 on Academic Activities at VFU "Chernorizets Hrabar", upon payment of an administrative fee and filling in an electronic form no later than seven days before the exam date.

You can submit a request on the University website ⇒ Students ⇒ Class schedule, or through Student status.



CERTIFICATES OF STUDENT STATUS

These are issued by Student Services to certify student status to other institutions, companies, employers, etc. An administrative fee is payable after completion of the first year.

APPLICATIONS AND REQUESTS

Applications and requests are submitted electronically on the website of VFU “Chernorizets Hrabar” ⇒ Students ⇒ Student status, or to Student Services. Students can apply for/request:

- Payment in instalments
- Semester fee reduction
- Interruption of studies
- Re-enrolment
- Transfer from one mode of study to another or from one degree programme to another.
- Transfer to another higher education institution
- Flexible examination arrangements or postponement of an examination/examination session for valid reasons
- Issuance of an academic transcript
- Other applications/requests

INTERRUPTION

At a student's request, interruption of student status for one academic year is permitted by the dean of the faculty or the director of the branch on the basis of an application submitted before the beginning of the academic year and upon payment of an administrative fee. A student's studies are suspended administratively for one academic year in the following cases:

More than three exams remain outstanding after the final resit examination session;

The semester fee has not been paid by the deadline;

More than three exams remain outstanding at the end of the respective academic year for students conditionally enrolled under Article 50(1) of the Ordinance No. 1 on Academic Activities;

The curriculum requirements concerning successful completion of semester exams and acquisition of credits have not been met after the remedial session of the final semester of study.

During the suspension period, students may sit the missed exams only with an individual examination form issued after paying an administrative fee and completing an electronic form no later than seven days before the exam date.

If the interruption period expires and no application for re-enrolment has been submitted, the student is deregistered from the University.

RE-ENROLMENT

Before the interruption period expires, but no later than the beginning of the semester in which studies are to resume, the student submits an application for restoration of student status.

TRANSFER

Applications for transfer from one speciality to another or from one form of study to another must be submitted no later than 15 days before the beginning of the semester.

Transfer to another higher education institution is permitted after submission of an application and payment of a penalty for early termination of the educational process. The amount is determined by an order of the President of VFU “Chernorizets Hrabar”, in accordance with Ordinance No. 5 on the University's Financial Management.

FAST-TRACKED EDUCATION

Students can shorten the duration of their studies by one year, provided they have successfully completed their first year with a grade point average no lower than Very good (5). Applications must be submitted no later than 30 days before the beginning of the academic year. Students taking up fast-tracked study pay semester fees for the full course of studies.

FLEXIBLE EXAMINATION ARRANGEMENTS

Flexible examination arrangements (permanent session) enable students to sit examinations on dates other than those scheduled for their academic year and form of education, within the announced examination sessions, with free individual examination forms until the end of the academic year. These arrangements are permitted for students with severe illnesses, people with disabilities, pregnant students, mothers with children up to six years old, and for other valid reasons.

Students must submit an application and documents justifying the need for these arrangements to student@vfu.bg or to Student Services. These arrangements are permitted provided that the semester fee for the current semester has been paid.

GRADUATION

Training in each speciality to obtain the relevant educational qualification degree ends with a state exam or a thesis defence according to the current legislation and approved curricula for the speciality. Students are admitted to the state exam or thesis defence provided that they have successfully passed all semester exams and met the other requirements of the academic programme.

HEALTH INSURANCE

Students enrolled in full-time studies who are under the age of 26 and are not subject to health insurance on different legal grounds according to the Health Insurance Act, fill out a health insurance declaration with the enrolment documents.

If the declared circumstances change, students are required to fill out a new declaration, which they submit to office # 111 – Finance and Accounting Department.

SEMESTER FEES

The amounts of semester fees and the deadlines for their payment are determined annually and published on the University website. Fees are paid by bank transfer to the following bank accounts of VFU “Chernorizets Hrabar” or at the University's Cashier's Office (room 115)

NATIONAL ELECTRONIC STUDENT CARD (NESC)



<https://nesc.nacid.bg>

The National Electronic Student Card (NESC, Bulgarian: HECK) verifies the enrolment status of students or doctoral candidates and entitles its holder to discounts and services at higher education institutions, student canteens, museums, theatres, public transport, and other venues.

The card is issued automatically based on information provided by the higher education institution or research organisation. Access is obtained by activating a profile in the National Electronic Student Card portal, for which NACID (National Centre for Information and Documentation) sends an email. If the automatic message is not received, a new email can be requested through the portal.

Issuance is free of charge. The card is valid for the entire period of study and is reissued only in case of a change in personal data. It can be used as a PDF document or directly on a mobile device. Individuals without “Active” status do not have access to the NESC.

Uniform Academic Number (UAN)

The Uniform Academic Number (UAN, Bulgarian: EAH) is the personal identification number of the student or doctoral candidate in the national register. It is used to verify the validity of the card and the current enrolment status: Active, Interrupted, Inactive, In the process of graduation, or Graduated. The data in the portal depend on the timely submission of information by the respective higher education institution or research organisation.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT IDENTITY CARD (ISIC) AND EUROPEAN YOUTH CARD (EYC)

The International Student Identity Card (ISIC) and the European Youth Card (EYC) certify student status and provide access to discounts in Bulgaria and around the world – transport, museums, entertainment, shopping, travel and accommodation.

- ISIC – for students enrolled in full-time studies.
- EYC – for students up to 30 years of age enrolled in part-time studies.

Both cards serve as campus access passes. They are valid for four years for university access and for one year for discounts, after which they must be renewed. The cards are personal and non-transferable.

In case of loss or misuse, security must be notified and an application for a new card submitted.

Postgraduate qualification

The doctoral programmes of Varna Free University "Chernorizets Hrabar" are designed to train highly qualified specialists with in-depth theoretical knowledge and the skills to conduct independent scientific research. Graduates are awarded the educational and scientific degree of Doctor (PhD) in the respective professional field. The doctoral programmes are attended by Bulgarian citizens and citizens of other countries, including Israel, Poland, China, Kazakhstan, Lebanon, Ukraine, Turkey, the Russian Federation and Cameroon. Teaching and supervision in the doctoral programmes are provided by the departments of Varna Free University, with the Centre for Doctoral Training at VFU "Chernorizets Hrabar" performing a coordinating role.

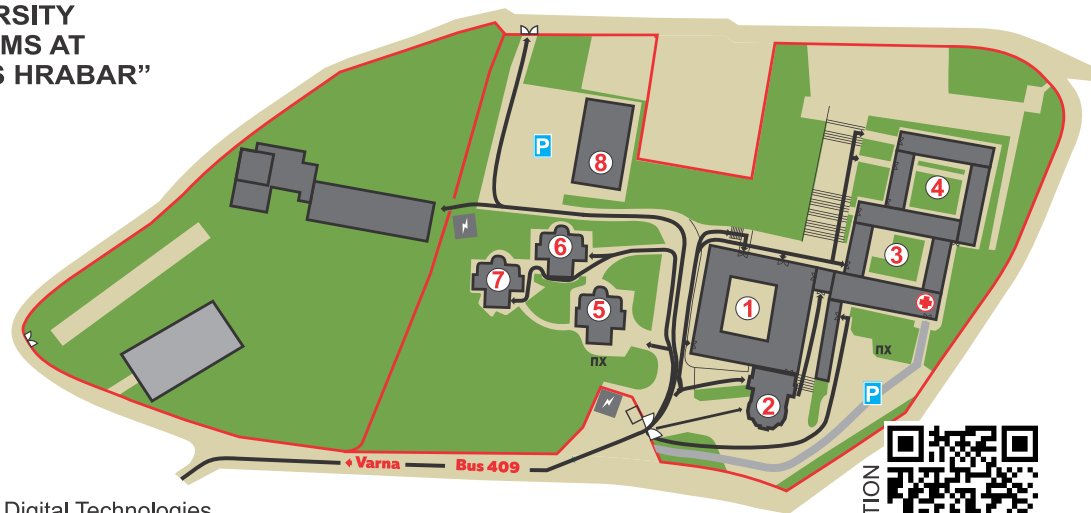
