9. **Learning outcomes:** To introduce the students to the matter of the architectural space and its perception; To form a sense of the specific interior art language of architectural styles; To provide a basis for assessment of contemporary trends in interior design and attitude towards the great masters of interior and design in the world and Bulgarian practice and theory.
10. **Mode of delivery:** face-to-face
11. **Prerequisites and co-requisites:** it is necessary for the students to have seriously entered the essence of the design activity and have undergone training in typology of residential and public buildings.
12. **Course content:** The course introduces the students to the main features of the interior space in architecture and its interaction with the exterior. It clarifies the relationship "man-space", the issues of perception, evaluation, information processes and corresponding means of expression – aesthetic value of the subject-space environment. There is a historical review of the architectural styles in the interior and the style of the furniture. Through a comparative analysis of prominent works of architecture from different styles, a connection with the epoch, the aesthetically durable value that links today's generations to those millennia back in time, is commented on.
