Extending the preparation in the field of:
 - designing in the environment of MC (monuments of culture);

 - post-liberation – residential, cult, public, industrial, commercial (types of materials and techniques, graphic reconstructions, exposure, socializing and adaptation);
 - from the end of XIX and the first decades of XX c. – residential, cult, public, industrial, commercial.
