9. Learning outcomes of the course unit: The objective of the course in Commercial Law is to acquaint students with the main problems of legal regulation of commercial turnover: principles and conditions for doing business in the country, the establishment and conduct of business by companies and sole traders, the nature of signed commercial deals, the rights and obligations of the parties thereto, limitation, the main types of commercial deals.
10. Mode of delivery: face-to-face
11. Prerequisites and co-requisites: Students should have knowledge of General Theory of Law and Civil Law – general part.
12. Course contents: The course in Commercial Law takes into account the need for student to acquire thorough knowledge of the specific set of legal rules and institutions that regulate social relations in the field of commercial turnover. The course provides knowledge on the subjects of business activities and relationships that occur between them and other people, different commercial companies – entities; liquidation proceedings; procedures for declaring insolvency and others. The course is fundamental and lays the foundations for future development of students.
